

The "morning" milking takes place at what most human beings call "night"



Morning, what did I miss??? Nodded off at 10pm...


Tel Aviv is known as the Non-Stop City. Mitzpe Ramon, the town at the end of the world near a crater, population 5000, is somewhat sleepier...

Haifa is notorious for having no night-life


